[What are the aims of the Eagle Squadron Readers Club?](#)

- To build a love of books and reading
- To encourage children to enjoy library books
- To introduce a wide selection of books
- To increase the number of books Early Years students read
- To encourage independent borrowing
- To support the learn-to-read programs in the school

[How does the ESRC work?](#)

1. Collect your Eagle Squadron Readers Club Card from the Library
2. Choose and borrow a book from the EJSS Library
3. Read the book. Record the book's title on your ESRC (*Library books only please*)
Parents are requested to fill in Squadron cards if your child needs assistance.
4. Return the book and hand in your card to acquire your stamp
5. Select and borrow another Library book
6. When you have filled 20 spaces on the ESRC, give it to the Library staff/monitors

[Who can join?](#) All Year 1 & Year 2 students enrolled at Eagle Junction State School

[How many books need to be read?](#)

20 books per card (see below)
1 Library book = 1 stamp
1 book bag = 1 stamp

[When can we change books?](#)

- Monday to Friday 8:15 – 8:35am - Parents can also borrow Book Bags at this time
- During weekly class borrowing time
- Students can borrow at first break. Remember to bring your Library bag and make sure you check the opening times on the door so that you can borrow. *Break times vary to according to lesson timetables*
